

1. BRIEF INTRODUCTION OF ASEAN COOPERATION ON EDUCATION



 ASEAN Charter (Article 1, para 10) – purposes of ASEAN:

"develop human resources through closer cooperation in education and life-long learning, and in science and technology, for the empowerment of the peoples of ASEAN and for the strengthening of the ASEAN Community".

- Social dimensions of development in ASEAN:
- (1) to <u>narrow the development gaps</u>,
- (2) to prepare youth for regional <u>leadership</u>,
- (3) to increase the competitiveness of the people.

The ASCC Blueprint 2016-2025:

- actions relevant to education under SOM-ED.
- In its implementation, SOM-ED will coordinate with other relevant ASEAN Sectoral Bodies (with an Interest in education).

The ASEAN 5-Year Work Plan on Education 2016-2020:

 Based on "ASEAN (ASED/SOM-ED) Post-2015 Vision and Key Elements of Education".



2. ASEAN Post-2015 Vision on Education

 VISION: The ASEAN education sector will continue to promote a Community that puts people at its centre as well as one with an enhanced awareness of ASEAN. It remains steadfast in its focus on sustainable development in the region, with emphasis on access to quality inclusive education development of life-long learning through robust capacity building programmes and provision of structural guidelines.

3. ASEAN Post-2015 Key Elements of Education

Key Elements:

- Promote ASEAN awareness through strengthening of Southeast Asian history and indigenous knowledge;
- 2. Enhance the quality and access to basic education for all, including the disabled, less-advantageous and other marginalized groups;
- Strengthen the use of Information and Communication Technology (ICT);
- 4. Support the development of the TVET sector well as lifelong learning in the region;

3. ASEAN Post-2015 Key Elements of Education

- Key Elements:
- 5. Complement the efforts of other sectors in meeting the objectives of Education for Sustainable Development;
- 6. Strengthen the higher education sector through the implementation of robust quality assurance mechanisms;
- 7. Foster the role of higher education in the area of socio-economic development through University-Industry Partnership; and
- 8. Provide capacity-building programs for teachers, academics and other key stakeholders in the education community.

 - (5.2) Promotion of the inclusion for Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) in national curriculum through support to relevant sectors' initiatives.




5. MECHANISMS OF ASEAN COOPERATION ON EDUCATION
