Understand local needs to **target resources effectively**, to **foster participation** and **increase accountability**.*

*Legal and fiscal decentralization according to the principle of subsidiarity is required to carry out these tasks.



Bring together and balance all sectors and interests in their communities. They can and should play a **leadership role** in developing and implementing a shared vision for the future.

Local economic development strategies



Act locally to address global challenges and to manage the impact of global phenomena at local level (climate change adaptation, migration, the mediation of globalizing economic and cultural forces).



Drive national development from the bottom up to create balanced systems of cities



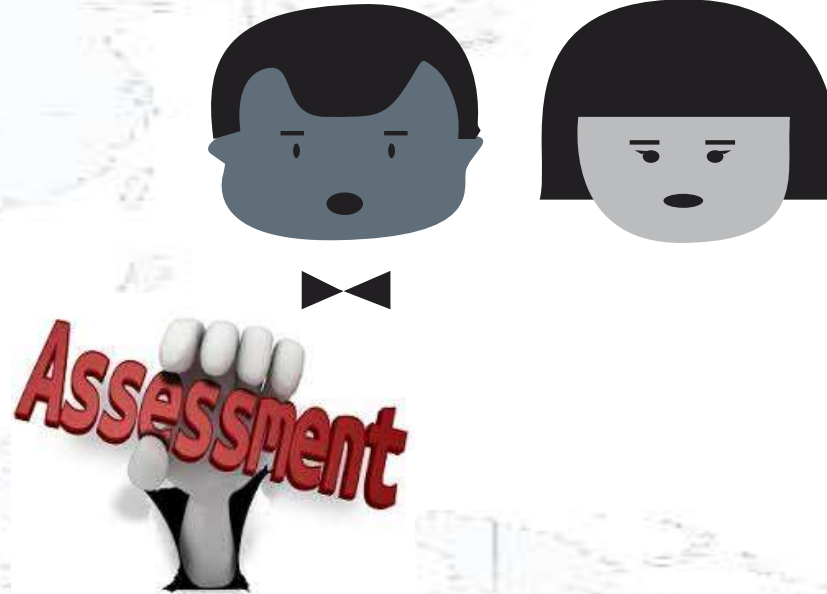
Local governments can contribute to more effective and accountable international governance if we are recognized as a sphere of government and given a seat at the global table.

Rapid assessment to local government on the best way to communicate on SDGs --> communication toolkits/strategy

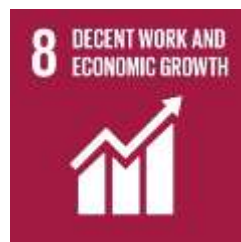

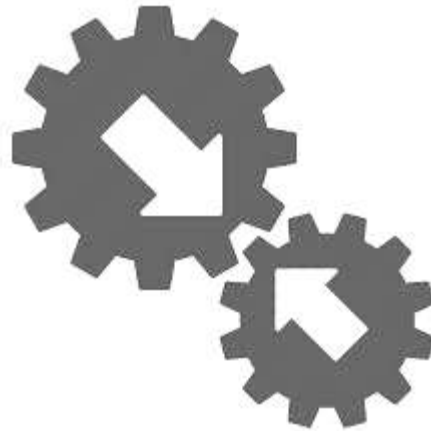

Ensuring efficient implementation of local and regional flagship projects included in the plans



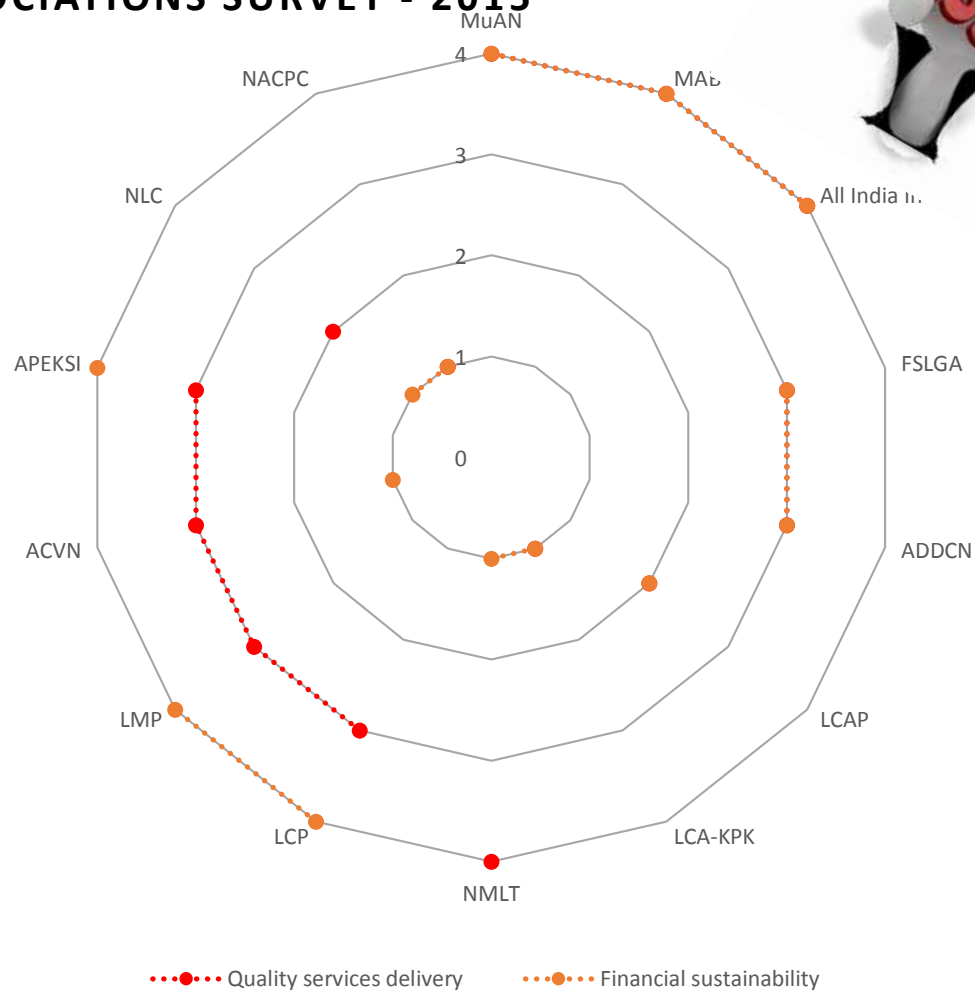

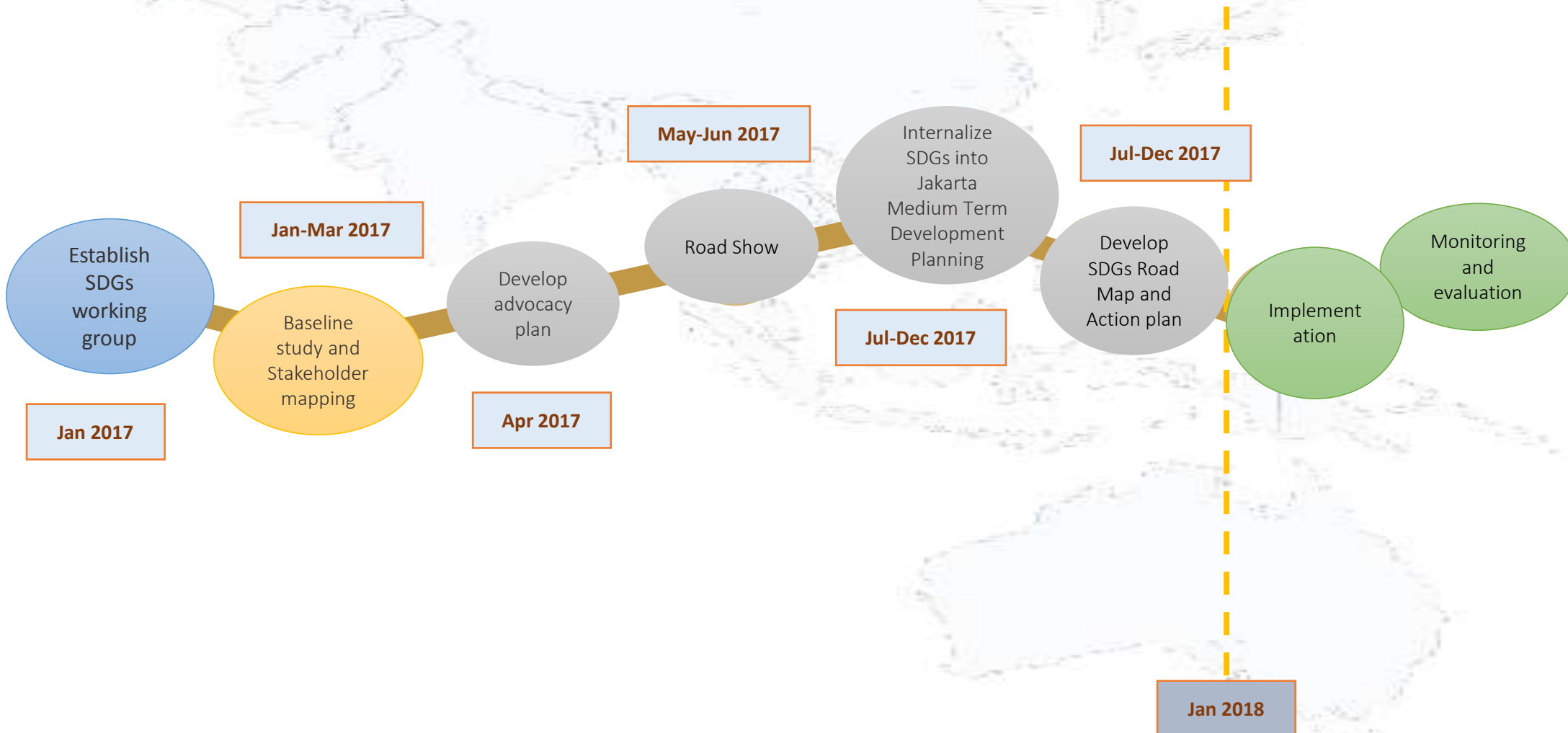

Road Map in Localizing SDGs

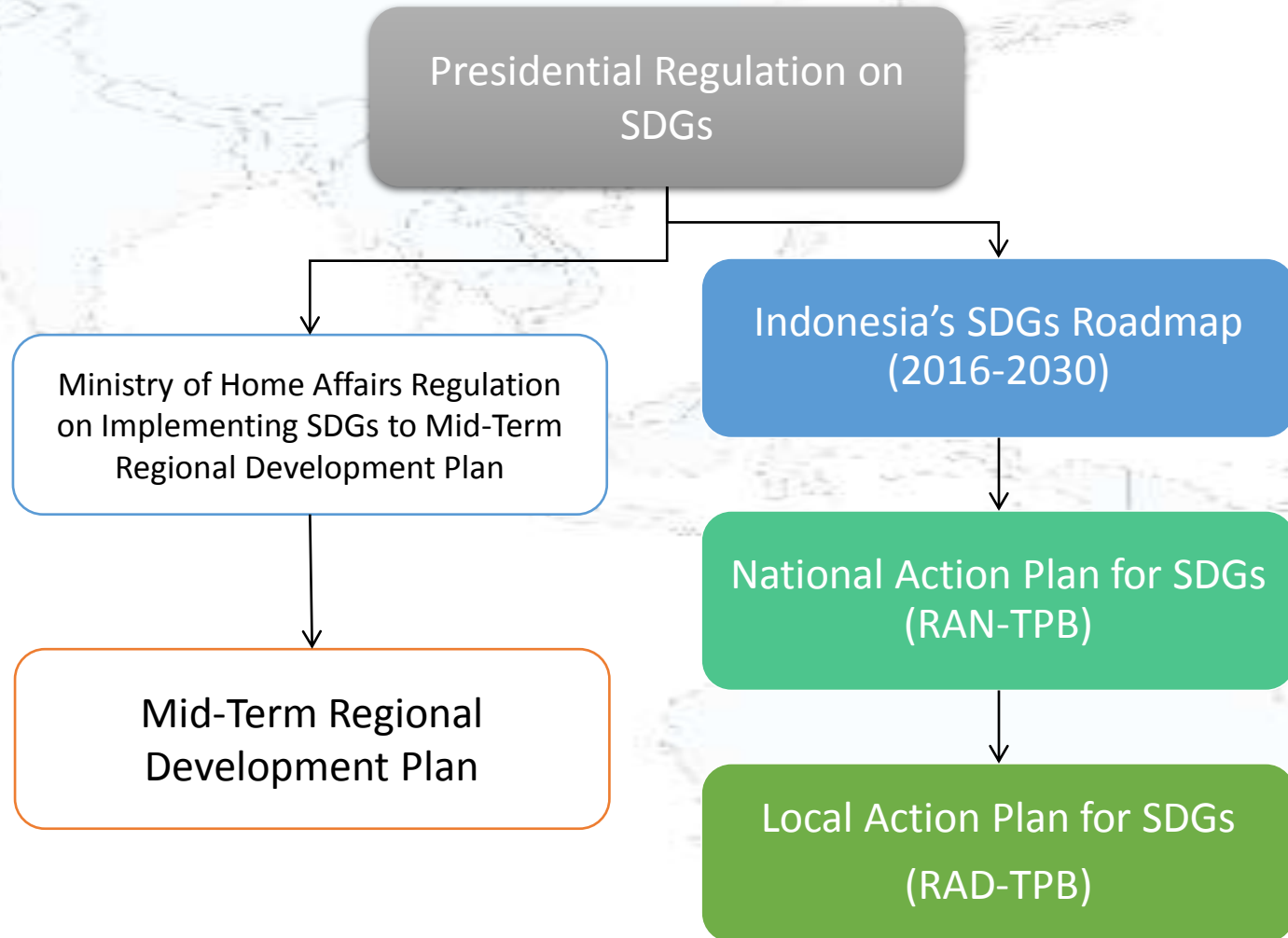
SDGs ROAD MAP for Local Governments

Opportunities

Strong willingness from national government to localizing SDGs

There will be 171 local election that held in June 2017
