-Every year, CRC have RCY clubs and leaders meeting held by President of CRC. RCY and RCV always shared about main point of humanitarian activities in their community and experiences also.

2. YABC conduct training

-Youth as Agents Behavioural Change started a youth building urban resilience and integrate Youth School Safety (YSS) on the theme of social inclusion starting in 2017 by CRC Funded and with support of the European Union and Finnish Red Cross through IFRC Phnom Penh. The same approach and module which 11 National Society CRC have carried was to applied.

-At Cambodian Red Cross 7 Branches and 21 targets University, sessions on the theme :Youth on the move of social inclusion (activities: 1-Skill and development skill 2-Peer to Peer Network 3-Active listening and 4-Coordination Skills) for participants group of youth and volunteer had discussed real life experiences relating to the topic and developed an Action plan for dissemination to share the knowledge and behavioural change mindset

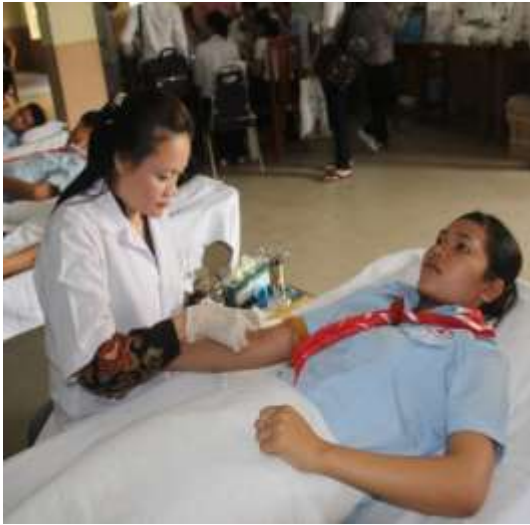


3. Road Safety Campaign
