Medical Illness or Injury

Medical facilities generally provide a good quality service in Melaka. Emergency response ambulances are available free of charge and are reliable. An ambulance and a team of paramedics will be put on standby throughout the event. The nearest hospital is Mahkota Medical Centre which is a private hospital whose charges differ from a government hospital. The nearest government-run hospital is the Melaka General Hospital.

Malaysia in Brief

Malaysia is located in Southeast Asia, separated by the South China Sea into two similarly sized regions, Peninsular Malaysia and East Malaysia (Malaysian Borneo). It consists of thirteen states and three federal territories. Peninsular Malaysia shares a land and maritime border with Thailand and maritime borders with Singapore, Vietnam and Indonesia. East Malaysia shares land and maritime borders with Brunei and Indonesia and a maritime border with the Philippines and Vietnam. The capital city is Kuala Lumpur, while Putrajaya is the seat of the federal government.

With a population of over 30 million, Malaysia is the 44th most populous country and is represented by multiple ethnic groups.

The official language is Bahasa Malaysia; English is widely used as an active second language. The currency is the Ringgit.

Malaysia has one time-zone abbreviated as MYT and it is UTC +8 hours.

Malaysia uses the standard UK 3 pin plug as per the photo below.


