# AMCDRR: The Opportunities

- Reflection on three years into the implementation of the Sendai Framework
- Review progress made against the commitments at the AMCDRR 2016, i.e. the New Delhi Declaration, the Asia Regional Plan, and ten stakeholder voluntary action statements
- Assess progress in Sendai Framework Monitoring
- Progress in achieving Target e of the Sendai Framework
- Reaffirm political commitment on DRR and strengthen coherent implementation of 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development

# The Asia Regional Plan



- Adopted at the 2016 Asian Ministerial Conference on Disaster Risk Reduction, New Delhi, India
- Guide and facilitate the implementation of the Sendai Framework in the region
- Key components:
  1. Broad policy directions [Coherence & integration; Guiding principles; Enabling environment]
  2. Long term road map [Milestones]
  3. Two-Year Action Plan 2017-2018 [Sendai Framework Priorities]
- Monitoring of the Asia Regional Plan – through the Sendai Framework Monitoring system

# Key Elements

- Focus on coherence across international agendas and their translation into policy and practices, at national, local and community levels
- Target E: National and Local Strategies by 2020
  - Backed by budgetary and financial measures
  - Inclusiveness
  - Localisation and community-level actions
  - Local and national platforms with high stakeholder engagement
- DRR Accountability
  - Systematic accounting of disaster loss and damages
  - Disaggregated data
  - Baselines
  - Sendai Framework Monitoring

# Key Elements

- Risk-informed investments:
  - Risk-sensitive investment in new and low-cost retrofitting of existing infrastructure
  - Public-private-partnership
  - Risk transfer and risk-sharing financial instruments
- Technology and research
- Early Warning – Early Action
- Recovery and BBB, including continuity of critical infrastructure and BSS
- Regional cooperation, capacity development and focus on countries with special needs

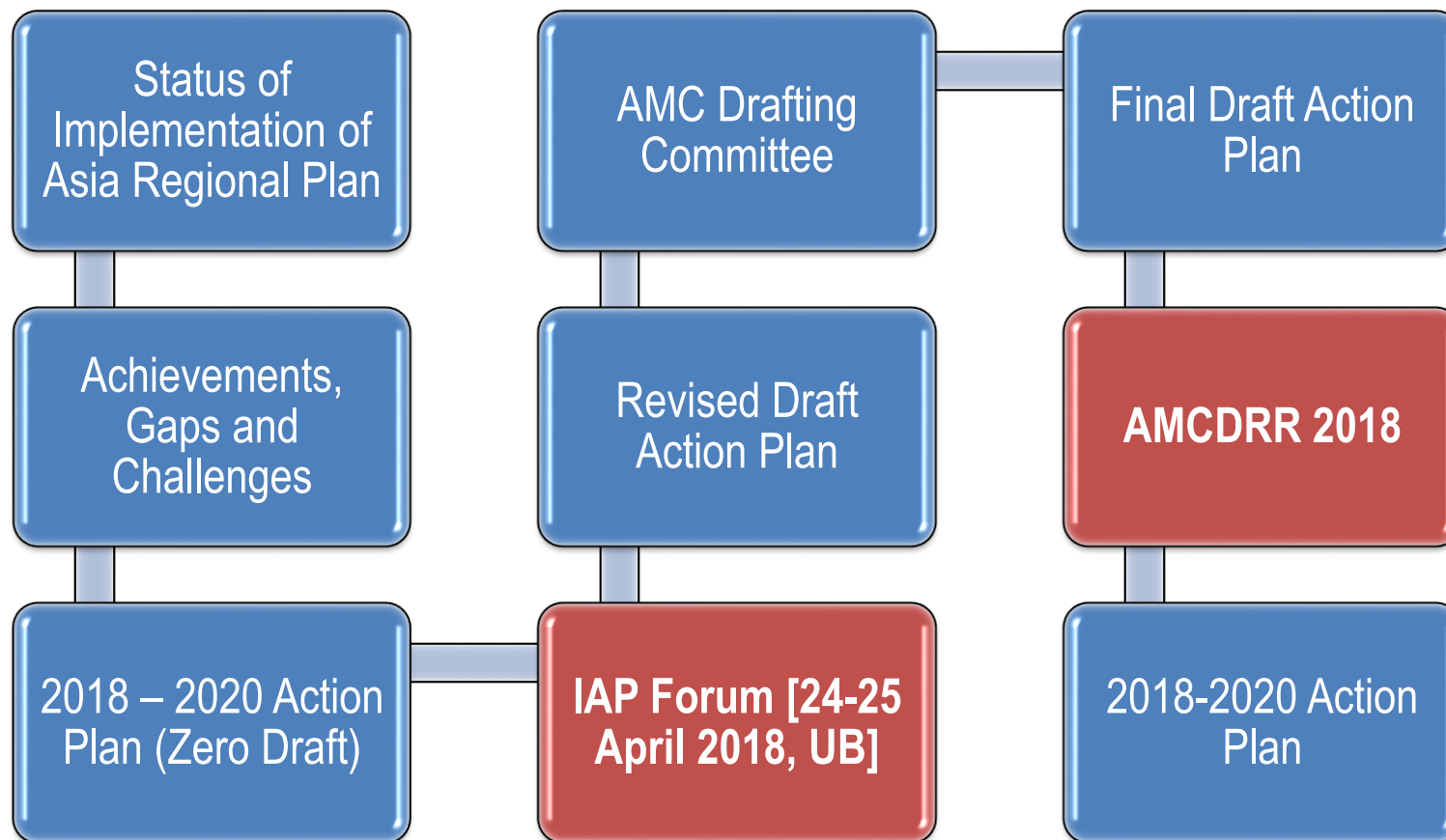

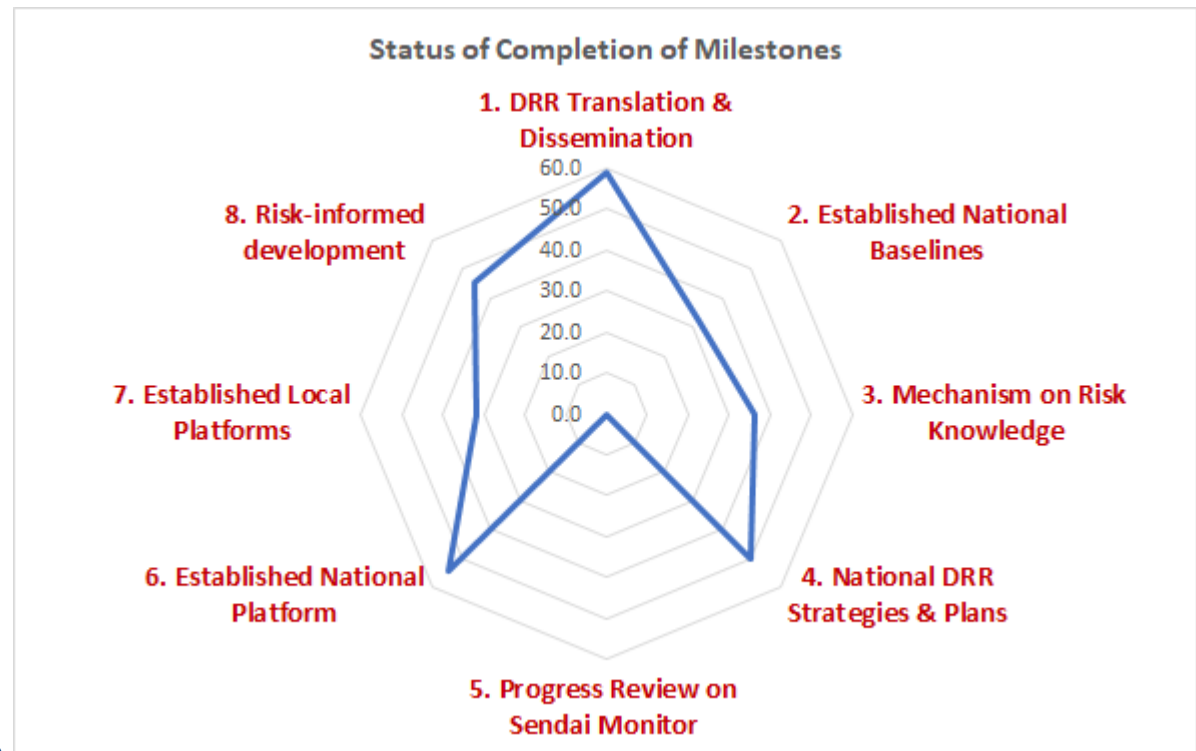

# Outlook: Milestones 2020

1. All countries have established methodologies to collect **disaster loss data and risk profiles**, with gender, age, disability disaggregated data.
2. All countries have revised/developed their **national strategies and/or plans for disaster risk reduction** with increased focus on **local actions**, achieving Sendai Framework Target e).
3. 30 percent of countries have developed regulatory or policy frameworks to reinforce **risk considerations and risk reduction measures into development initiatives**, in particular in the **infrastructure** sector
4. 60 percent of countries have established multi-sectoral and multi-stakeholder **national and local platforms**.
5. Review regional targets under the Asian Regional Plan from 2022-2028, every biennium.

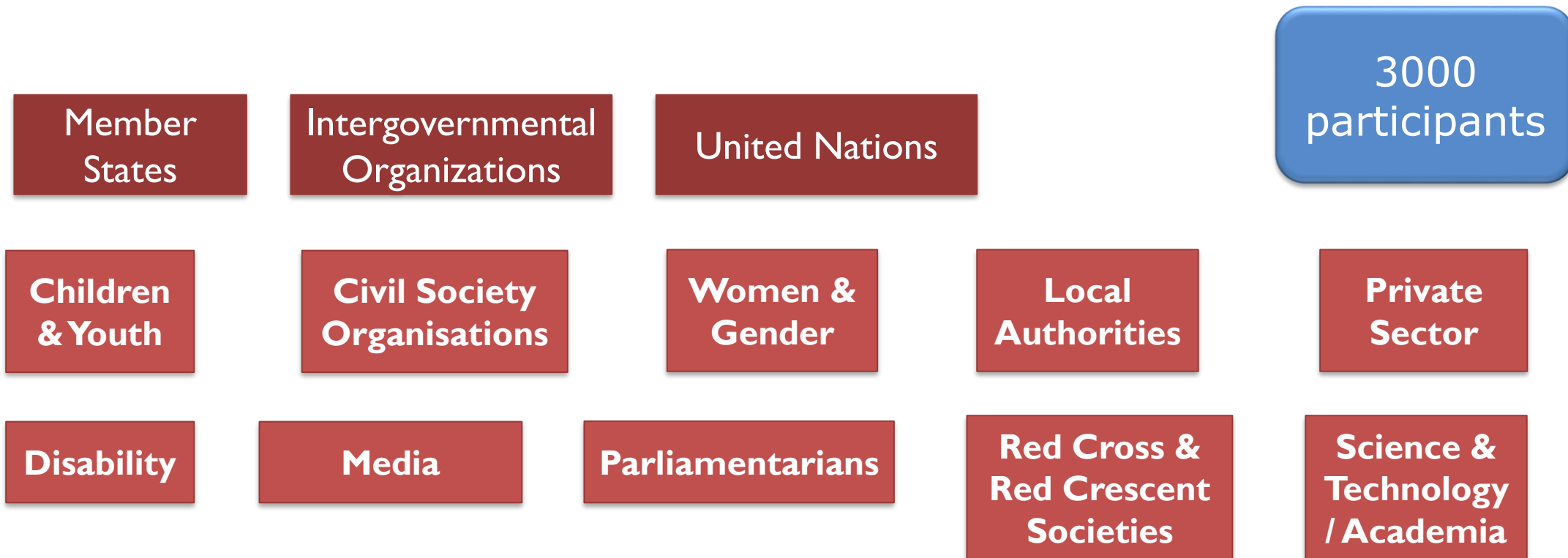
