Mr. Vilayphong has request Mary to submit a workplan for her technical support to the law drafting.

B. Presentation at DM Law Committee Meeting (June 19)

The DM Law Committee Meeting was attended by all members, including Lao Red Cross (Mr. Bounyong), and chaired by Mr. Vilayphong.

IFRC was the main resource person. UNDP sent an observer participant.

I presented for 2 hours on 4 sessions (Basic DRM concepts, Global/regional/domestic context of DL, DL tools, ASEAN country DL examples particularly PH and Viet Nam). Participants were very engaged and asked questions mostly on:

- Good examples of DRM funding in legislation, and how to reflect the priority for DRR in funding
- Operationalizing funding –
 how will the different
 Ministries access the DRM
 fund that will be lodged with
 MLSW as Chair of NDPCC
- Accountability and reporting requirements; how to avoid overlap of reports from different ministries
- How to use legislation to ensure that communities and vulnerable groups are engaged in DRM

ADB also requested me to present their slides for them since they cannot attend the meeting. I have requested Mr. Vilayphong to provide minutes of the meeting (in English).

C. Meeting with Dr. Kaviphone (July 19)

I had a brief meeting with Dr. Kaviphone and his team to update him on:

- summary of my presentation
- important meeting dates for the law drafting activities (encouraging him to attend the 2nd technical meeting)

Dr. Kaviphone updated me on the intervention/comments made by LRC President regarding the DM law, which are:

- Disaster report process: too many reports are required from members of NDPCC
- Fund-raising: overlapping fund-raising activities in Lao PDR for disasters; proposes to set up a mechanism where humanitarian/development partners will be assigned certain areas for funding and support
- Financial support to LRC from government: requests more funding from LRC on DRR (not just salary of staff), and if there is any way to expedite fund
- Some concern about how decision-making will be affected with MLSWS's authority as Chair of NDPCC (previously chaired by Lao PDR Vice President)
