## Projek Ikhlas 12.0 serlah keprihatinan masyarakat

**BANDAR SERI BEGAWAN, Jumaat, 17 April.** - Projek Ikhlas 12.0, Menyisihkan Kasih Ramadan anjuran Persatuan Bulan Sabit Merah Negara Brunei Darussalam akan diadakan pada 19 April 2020 ini.

Sehubungan itu, pihak peratuan berharap orang ramai yang berkesediaan untuk tampil dalam sama-sama membahagikan sumbangan berbentuk barangan keperluan harian seperti beras, tepung, minyak masak, gula, makanan ringan, malah mereka juga menerima bucar barangan dari pasar raya.

Presiden peratuan, Awang Haji Muhammad Subhani Haji Ibrahim kenka ditemu bual menjelaskan, orang ramai yang hendak menyumbangkan derma barangan tersebut bolehlah datang

menyerahkan secara sendiri ke (drive-thru) di Ibu Pejabat Persatuan Bulan Sabit Merah Negara Brunei Darussalam di Kawasas Letak Kereta, Pejabat Pos Busut satu di belakang Stesen Minyak Shell Damat. Penyerahan tersebut katanya, akan bermula dari jam 8.00 pagi sehingga 5.00 petang.

Mengulas tujuan projek tersebut, beliau menjelaskan bahawa barang-barangan yang diterima itu nanti akan diwarangkan kepada keluarga-keluarga yang kurang berkemampuan di negara ini termasuk golongan asnaf fakir miskin, asnaf musafir daif, warga emas yang berkesediaan serta orang yang berkeperluan khas.

Selain itu, sumbangan turut disediakan kepada keluarga-keluarga pesakit

COVID-19 yang sedang menjalani kuarantin di kediaman masing-masing.

Berlainan seterusnya berkata bahawa sumbangan ini diselenggarakan bagi sama-sama menyambat kedatangan bulan suci Ramadan yang akan menjelang tidak lama lagi. Tambahnya, inisiatif yang diinikong oleh para kakitangan peratuan ini, diharap akan dapat membantu pihak Kerajaan Kebawah Duli Yang Maha Mulia Paduka Seri Baginda Sultan dan Yang Di-Pertuan Negara Brunei Darussalam dalam menanganis isu kemiskinan asnaf fakir miskin dan mereka yang memerlukan.

Persatuan ini memang aktif dalam mengukaykayahkan tiga hingga empat projek ikhlas di antaranya Projek Ikhlas Kembali ke Sekolah pada setiap bulan Disember. Projek Ikhlas Menyisihkan Kasih Ramadan yang diadakan setiap bulan Ramadan dan Hari Raya Aidilfitri. Manakala

Projek Ikhlas Khusus diselenggarakan jika ada musibah seperti banjir kilat, kebakaran rumah dan bencana-bencana alam yang lain.

Menyeri Projek Ikhlas ini juga, pihak peratuan juga berupaya menyedukakan BRC Food Aid bertujuan menyediakan bantuan makanan asas pada bila-bila masa diperlukan oleh masyarakat yang memerlukan tidak kira siapa dan dalam keadaan apa sekalipun.

Manakala School Aid juga disediakan untuk membantu anak-anak terutama pelajar di pelbagai peringkat dari rendah ke institusi pengajian tinggi yang memerlukan peralatan perskolahan.

"Seperti lazimnya, Persatuan Bulan Sabit Merah Negara Brunei Darussalam di keempat-empat daerah mempunyai dafat senarai nama penerima yang terdiri dari golongan asnaf fakir miskin dan asnaf musafir dan yang berkeperluan. Walau

bagaimanapun dari semasa ke semasa menerusi Food Aid boleh diagihkan kepada mereka yang memerlukan," katanya lagi.

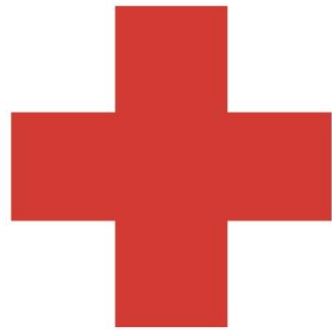

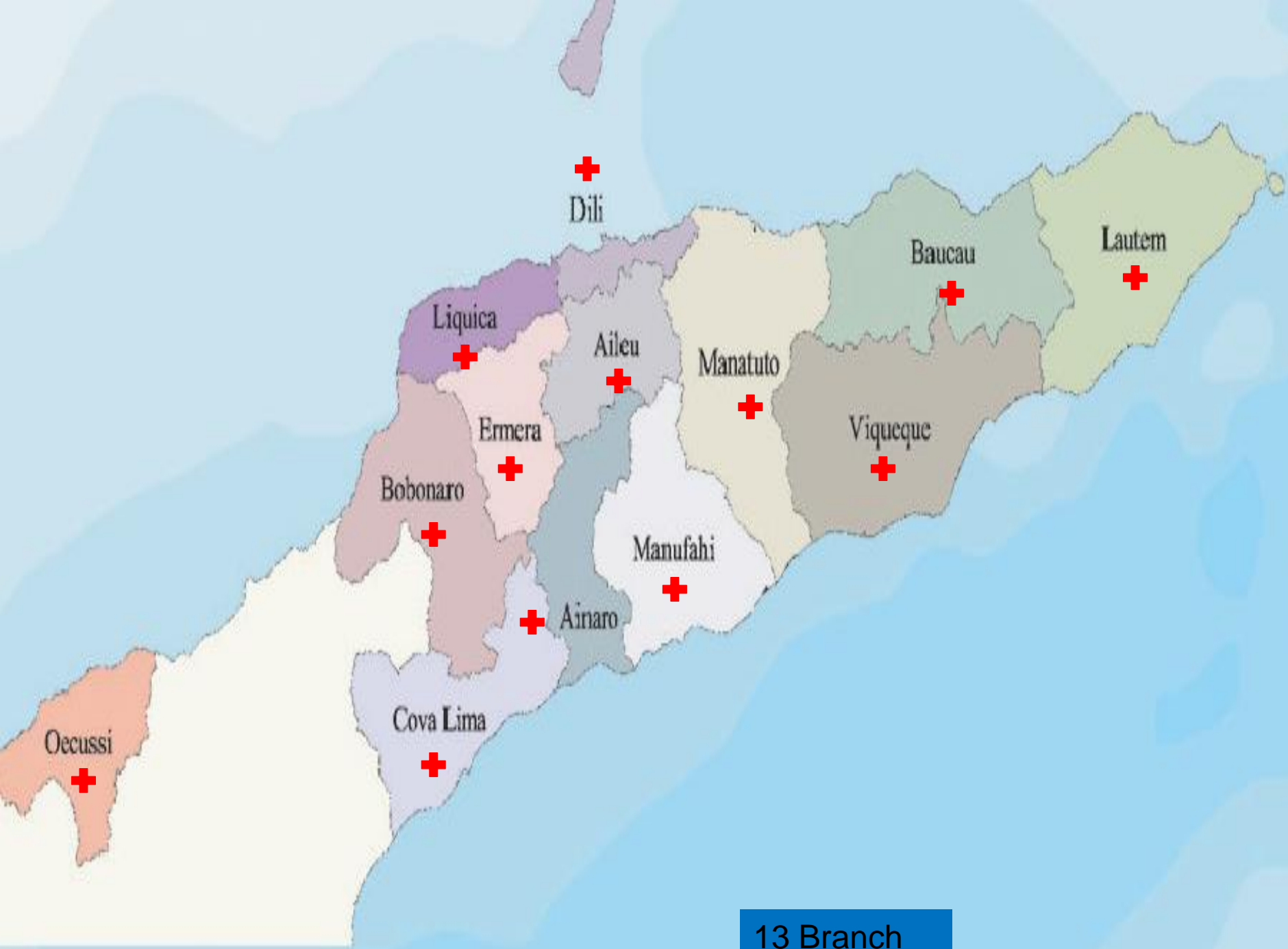

# Introduction

- \* Timor -Leste COVID-19 situation: cases detected in Dili Capital (322), Positive case (24) Recovery (6) Active cases (18); 19 people are in quarantine in Dili Capital; deaths (0).
- \* Timor-Leste Red Cross is a member of the National Integrated Operational management Center of COVID-19
- \* Timor-Leste RC sets up operation teams consisting of 24 nurses and 8 doctors and young volunteers in 13 municipalities
- \* Total 65 ps.





# CVTL Taks Force NHQ

- Prepare Plan Contingency for Covid-19
- Briefing on the COVID-19 outbreak
- Provide practices for personal health guidance including social & physical distancing (disinfection and health promotion activities)
- Distribute PPE for volunteers (Luvas, Masker)
- Info how to use the PPE
- Train how to do safe and proper disinfection to Volunteers and FFDTL
- Protocols when volunteer has symptoms, get infected by COVID, or accident
- Provide referral for health services in case the symptoms arise or infected by COVID
- Prepare tend distributed to each quarantine that used for Security (Team Task force) PNTL,PM,FFDTL



# CVTL Task Force Branch

- Clean and decontaminate the PPE
- Medical check after disinfection activity
- Maximum 2x doing disinfection in one day, with 1:30 minutes spraying time, in CVTL Office and also to FFDTL, Fatuhada, Policy Military (PM), Resident of Lere Anan Timor
- General Kitchen
- Prepare tend distributed to each quarantine that used for Security ( Team Task force)PNTL,PM,FFDTL
- Provide Hygiene Material
- Socialization awareness Covid 19 to Communities 13 Branch
- Cooperated with relevant NGO and INGO for example in Aileu with plan,Covalima Oxfan,

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## ***Youth Volunteers in action!***

### ***Taking Care of volunteers***

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- PRIOR:
  - Do you have a system in place to **communicate quickly** with local branches and volunteers? Has this system been tested?
  - Do you have a system in place to **provide PSS during and after the operation**, for staff and volunteers?
    - Are volunteer managers **trained in and able to provide PFA** to support volunteers in distress? Reference: <http://pscentre.org/>
  - Are **self-care and violence prevention** in the workplace available?
  - Are **complaints and feedback mechanisms** in place to protect staff, volunteers and the communities they serve? And are all volunteers made aware of these and how to use them?

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## ***Youth Volunteers in action!***

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- DURING:
  - Are your staff and volunteers provided with appropriate **personal protection equipment** to do their tasks efficiently and safely? Have they been **trained on how to correctly use it**?
  - Do you ensure that staff and volunteers are given **rest and recovery** (rotation system)?
  - Are your staff and volunteers provided with appropriate **visibility items and identification material** recognised by authorities?
  - Do you have an **incident reporting system** and procedures to collect, record and report staff and volunteer incidents?

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## ***Youth Volunteers in action!***

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- DURING and AFTER:
  - Have you assigned a **contact point**, in case volunteers become unwell during or after their volunteering service? Have you disseminated this contact point to volunteers?
  - Do you have **space for daily debriefing and learning** from staff and volunteers?
    - Do you give time for staff and volunteers to reflect on what happened, and a space to share challenges and request help or guidance or support
  - Do you **thank and recognise** volunteers?
  - Do you ask for **evaluation and feedback from the volunteers?**

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## ***Youth Volunteers in action!***

### ***Taking Care of volunteers***

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#### **▪ INSURANCE STATUS**

The current IFRC Global Volunteer Insurance Scheme does not cover volunteers who may contract the Covid 19 infection while performing services, duties or work related to the Red Cross and Red Crescent

→ Fund for compensation in case of death

#### **→ VOLUNTEER SOLIDARITY FUND**

Model for solidarity fund at NS level, IFRC will assist in setting it up (technical assistance and start-up funding)
