- **To Equip them with basic knowledge and skills for School Based Risk Reduction.**

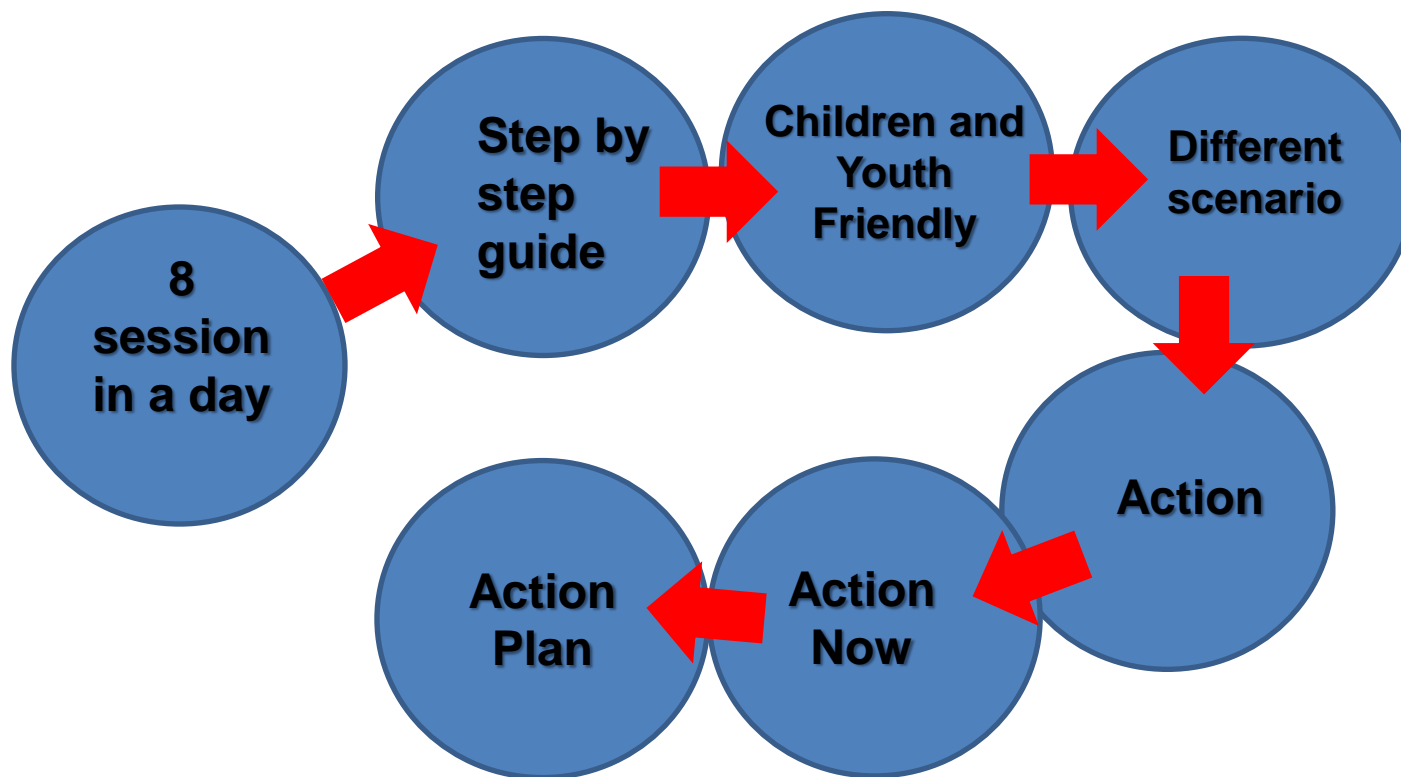

Main outcome of Myanmar training and its impact

- 11 trainings conducted within 3 months {student reached 229 /Male113, Female116}
- Going to continue 32 new schools and 1 University in 2017
- Schools implementing their action plan in a cooperation with local red cross branch
- Received good feedbacks from school stakeholders
- Youths also want to be involved in this programme. So, now youth can move faster



Recommendation to the school safety practitioners

- Endorse and further support children and youth to lead the school safety action.
- Recognize the importance of the youth empowerment and include our Youth in school safety toolkit as a key tool for ASEAN youth engagement in school safety and provide greater support and appropriate resources into them.
