4. NHQ Youth Committee Meeting (17 Youth Representatives)



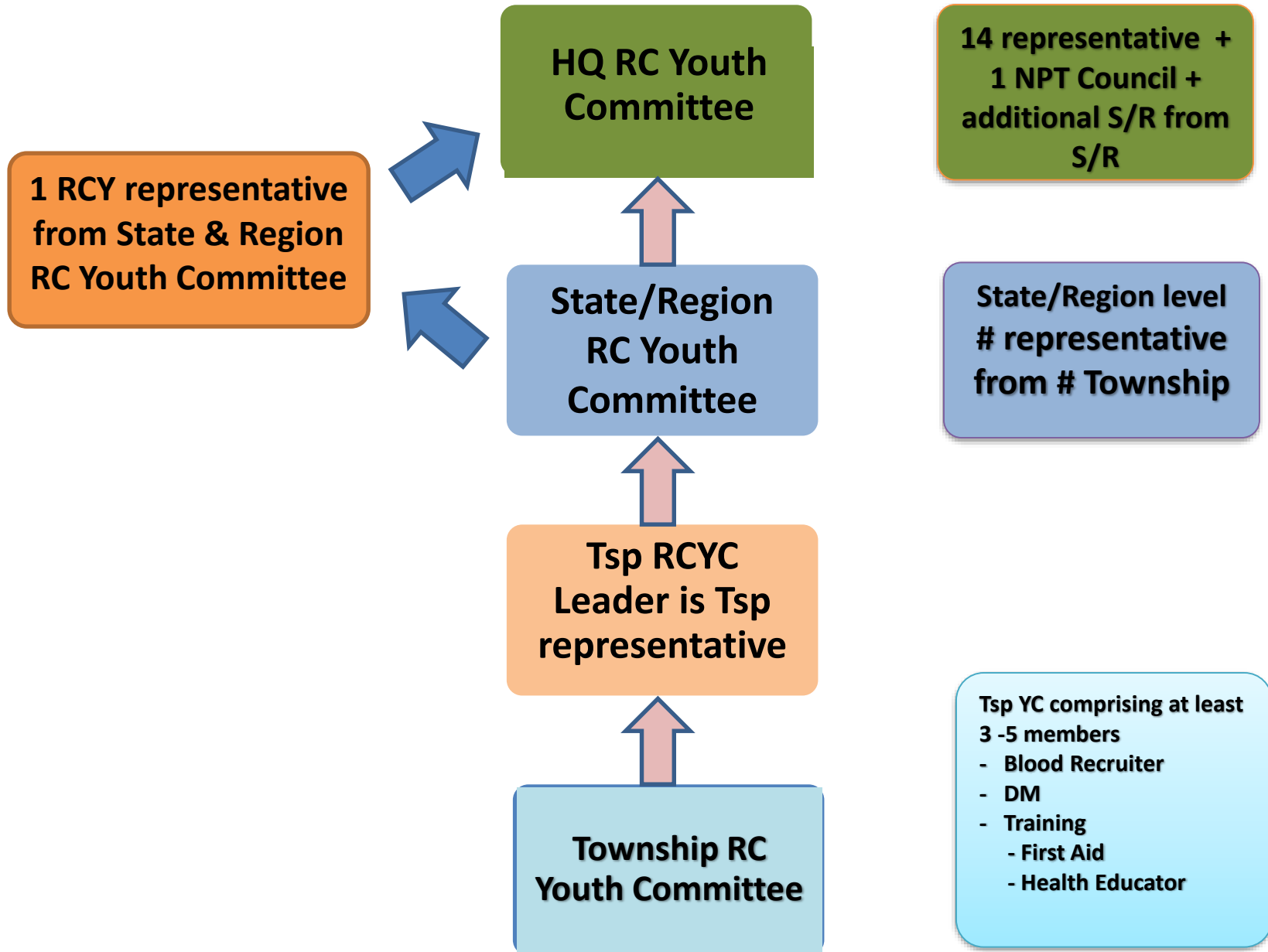
5) Supported to RCYC in their activities (such as Nutritional supports in Mass Blood Donation Events and First Aids Kits and teaching aids in FA trainings)
