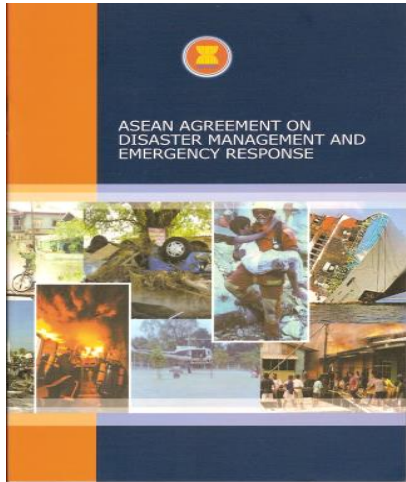

ASEAN Agreement on Disaster Management and Emergency Response (AADMER): An Overview



- AADMER is a comprehensive legal framework for all ASEAN Member States, which serve as a common platform in responding to disasters within ASEAN
- **Objective:** Reduce disaster losses in ASEAN countries, and jointly respond to disaster emergencies
- Initiated in mid 2004, signed by Foreign Ministers of ASEAN in July 2005
- Ratified by all ten countries, **entered into force on 24 December 2009**
- ASEAN Coordinating Centre for Humanitarian Assistance (AHA Center) as the operational coordination body and engine of AADMER

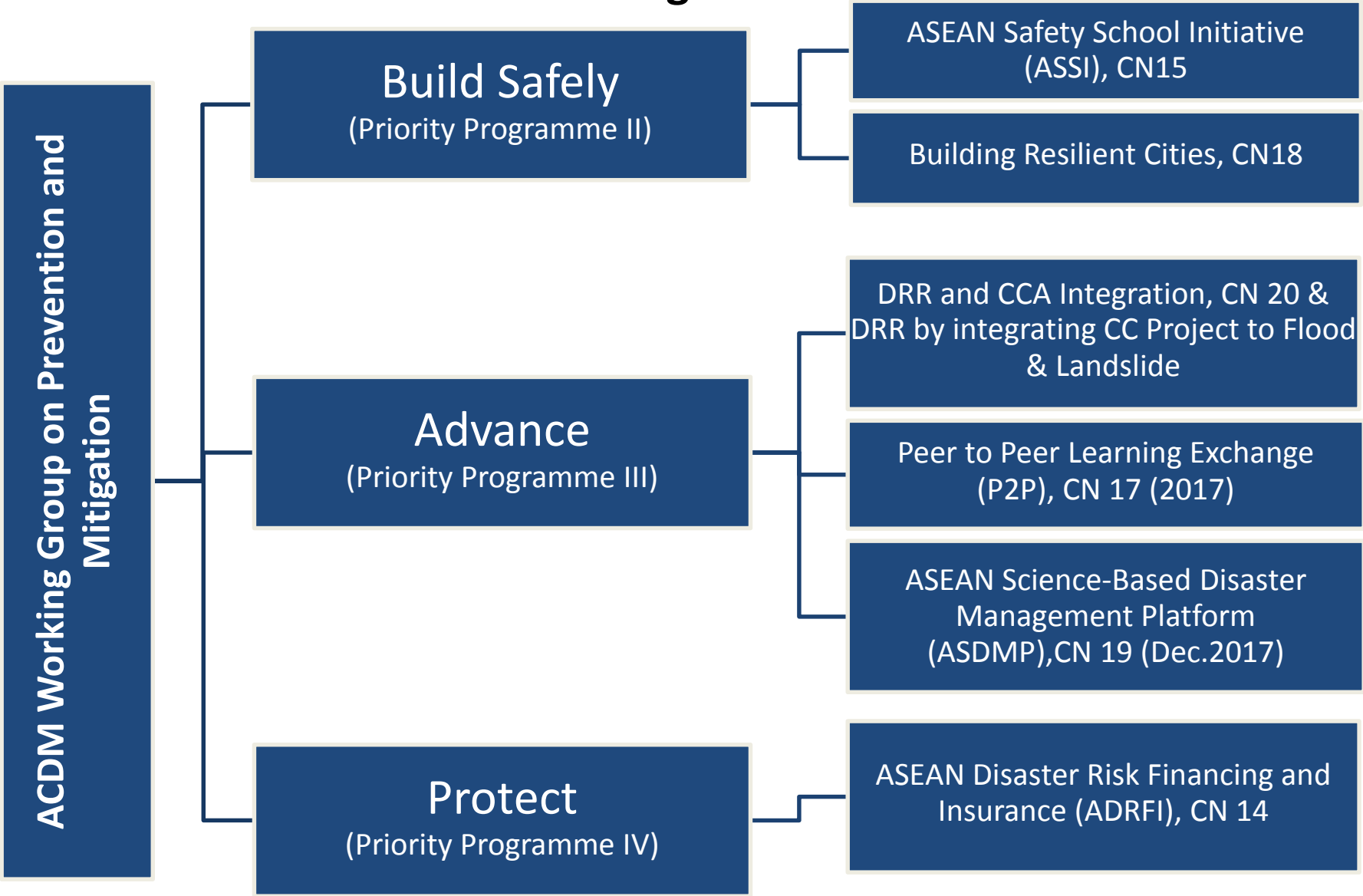

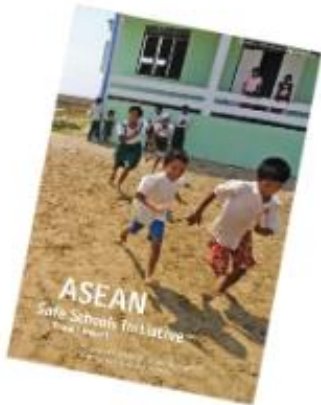

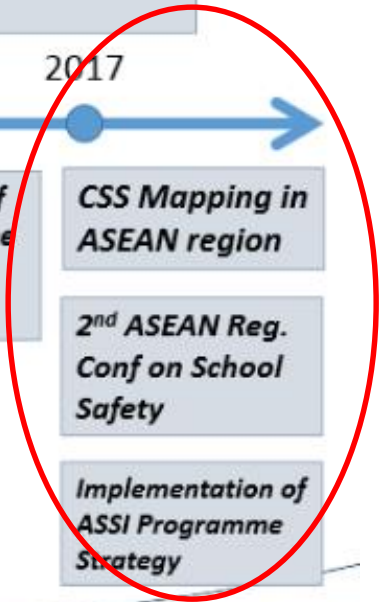


Development of ASSI Programme Strategy 2017-2020

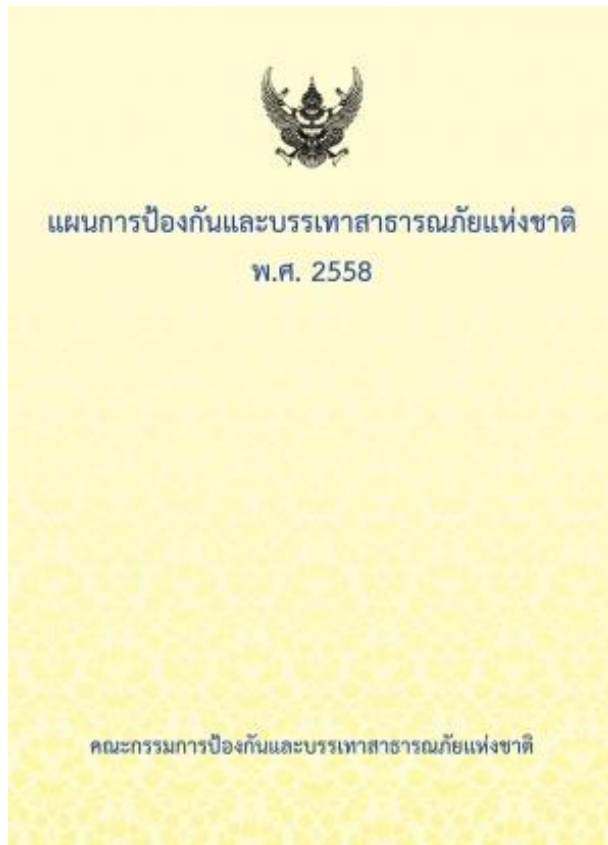

This current national plan has undergone a participatory planning process, where related sectors were engaged, including public, private and civil society.

The cabinet has approved National Disaster Prevention and Mitigation Plan 2015 on dated March 31, 2015.

NATIONAL DISASTER RISK MANAGEMENT PLAN 2015

Ministry of Education

(19.1) To develop educational curriculum at all levels to include disaster related subjects from primary to higher educational institutions.

(19.2) To encourage the educational agencies to take active role in disaster risk management efforts



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MINISTRY OF INTERIOR

Ministry of Education

(19.3) To take initiative steps to educate the students across all educational levels including the general public, to create awareness among them as well as inspiring them to actively participate in disaster risk management.

(19.4) To promote and encourage educational personnel, including boy and girl scouts and girl guides to support the functioning of the National Disaster Command headquarters and local Disaster Management Centre

(19.5) To conduct the survey and create educational facility database for the purpose of designating as temporary shelters in the event of disaster.

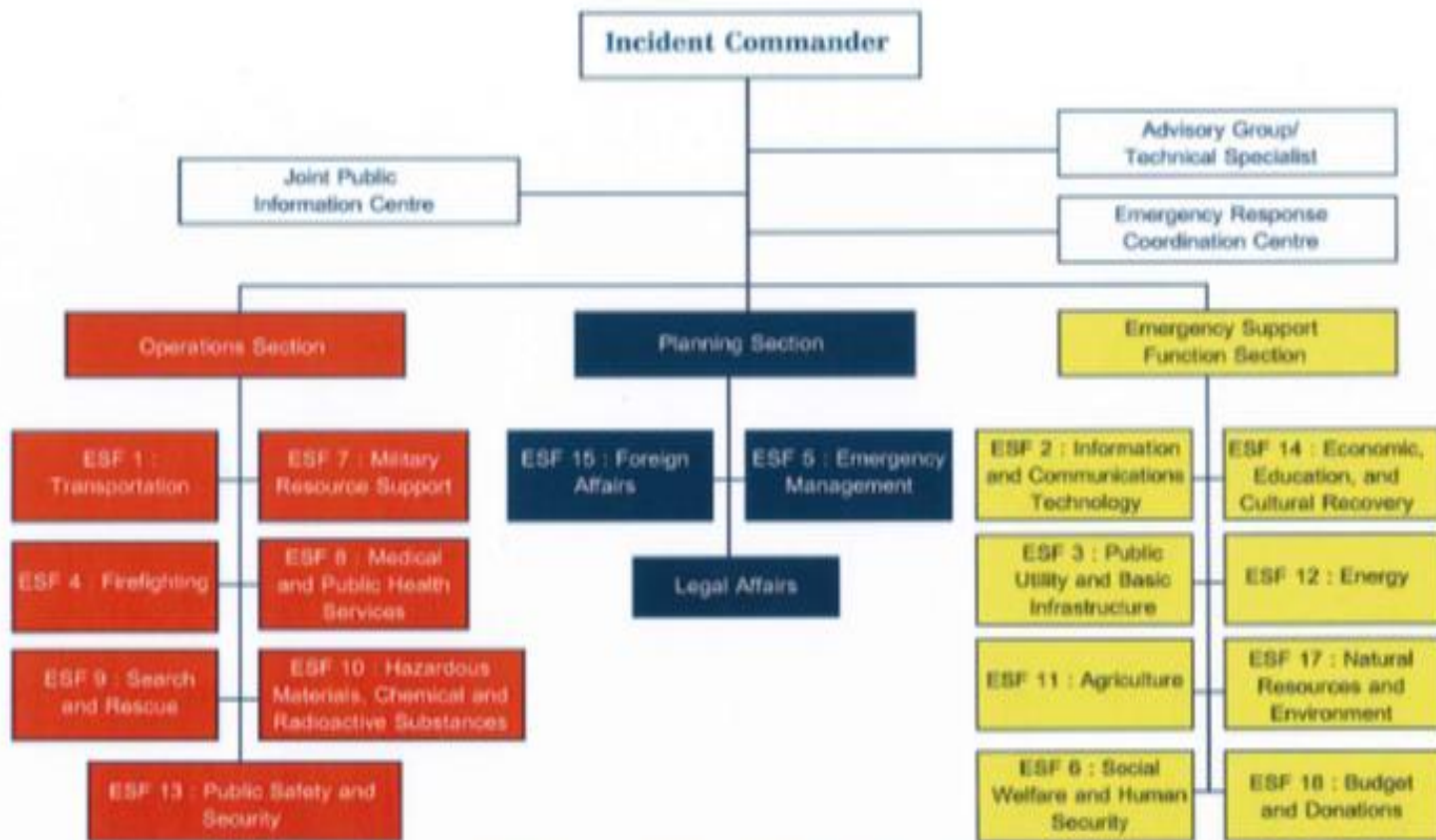


Chart 5-3 : Emergency Support Function : ESF



Emergency Support Functions

(5.14) Emergency Support Function 14 : Economic, Educational, and Cultural Recovery : encompasses the following activities

- 1) To assess the impacts of disaster on economic, education, and cultural sectors as well as on historical sites in disaster affected areas.
- 2) To provide recommendations, guidelines, and approaches for preparing to handle disaster situation as well as for implementing recovery and reconstruction programmes and activities.



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MINISTRY OF INTERIOR

- 3) To determine guidelines for both public and private sector organizations involved to follow when supporting and assisting long – term community recovery and in the long run, in reducing social and economic inequality within the communities.
- 4) To analyze, assess, prevent and mitigate the adverse impacts of disasters on historic and cultural sites.
- 5) To conduct site inspection for the purpose of restoring the damaged location of economic activities, educational services locations, location of historic and cultural resources to pre – disaster conditions as soon as possible.
