- Services in support of government activities related to COVID-19
  - A. Temperature screening especially for the returnees migrating from neighboring countries
  - B. Quarantine services
  - C. Community-based surveillance activities
  - D. Other support activities in collaboration COVID-19 multisectoral taskforce
- Psychosocial support
- Increased access to basic needs for displaced and restricted movement populations

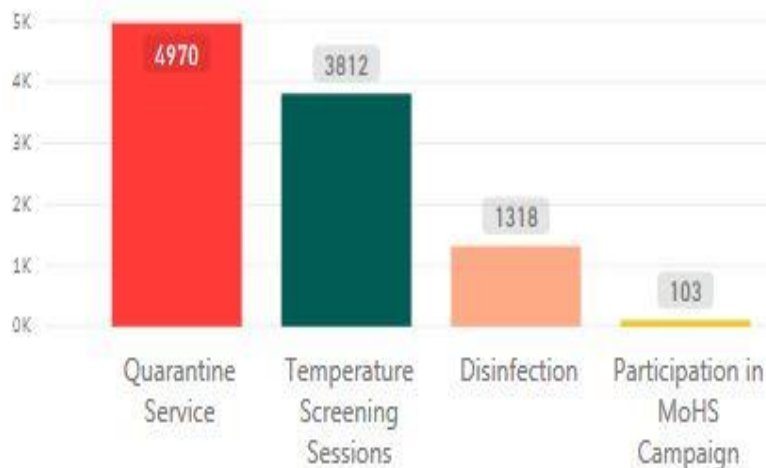

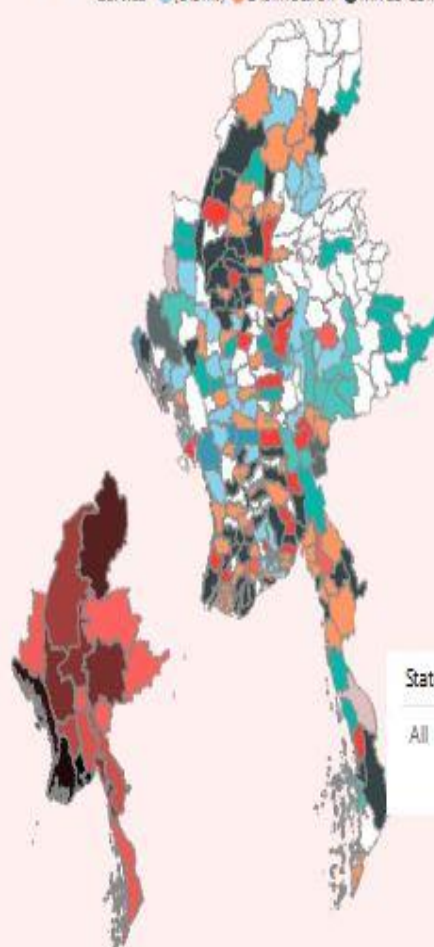

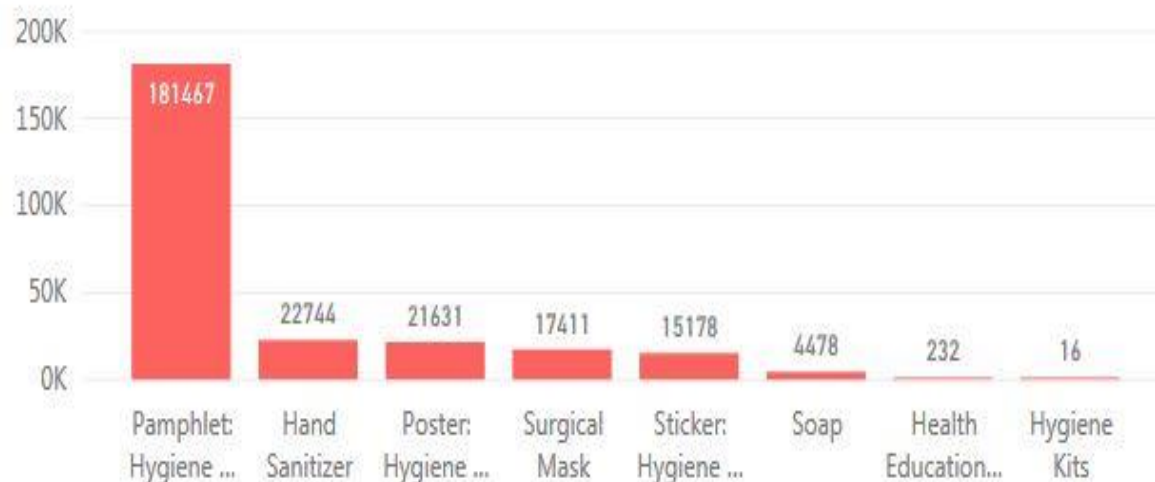

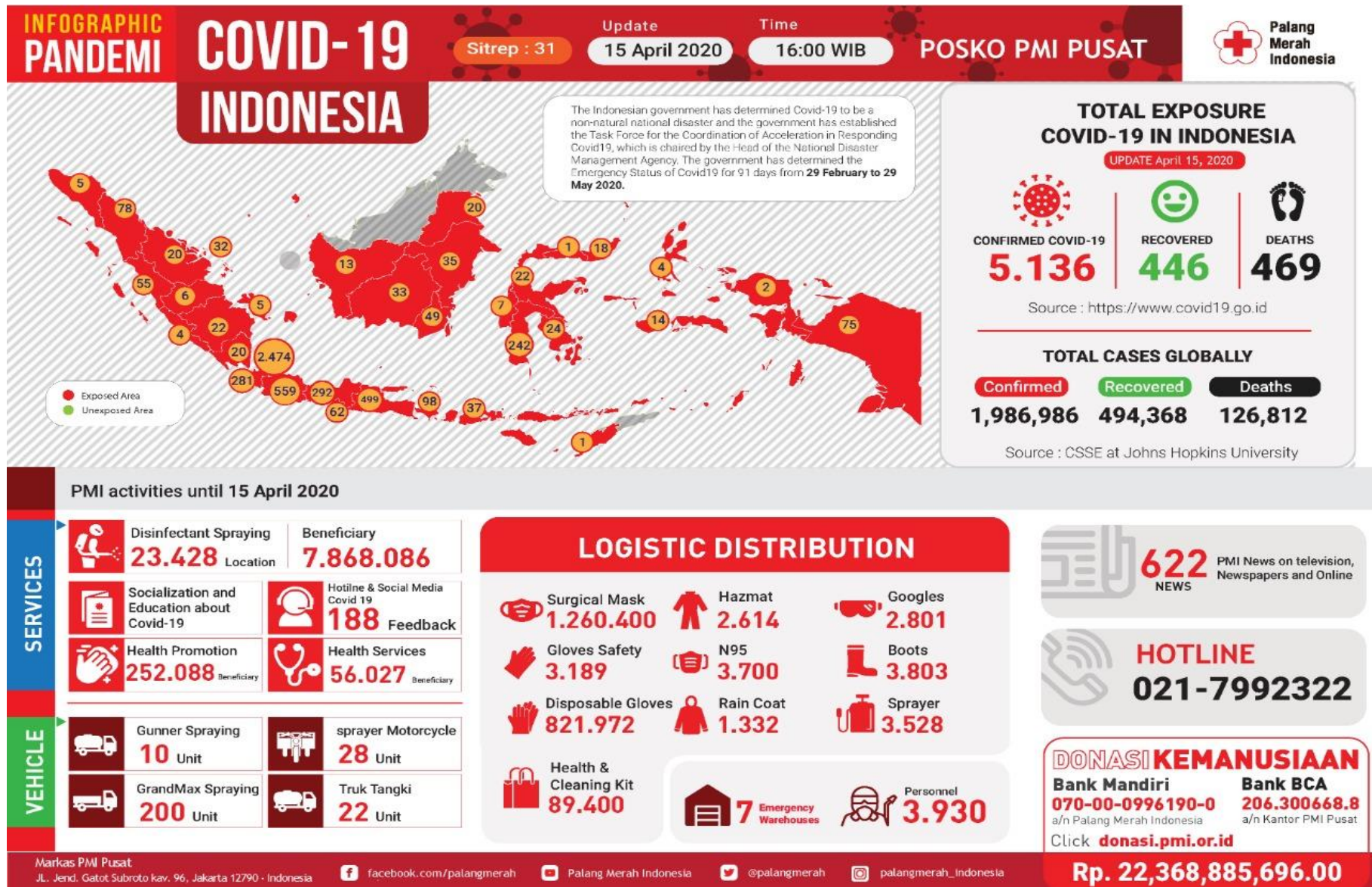

## *Managing PMI Volunteers for COVID-19 Operations*

- ☐ *Recruitment of new (spontaneous) volunteers and mobilization of existing volunteers*
- ☐ *Briefing*
- ☐ *Ensuring Volunteer Safety*
- ☐ *Providing Volunteer Care (debriefing, online PSS)*
- ☐ *Developing a Protocol for Volunteer Mobilization*



## *Ensuring Volunteer Safety for the COVID Operation (1)*

- ☐ *Briefing on the COVID-19 outbreak*
- ☐ *Provide practices for personal health guidance including social & physical distancing (disinfection and health promotion activities)*
- ☐ *Distribute PPE for volunteers*
- ☐ *Train on how to use the PPE depending on the purpose*
- ☐ *Train how to do safe and proper disinfection*
- ☐ *Protocols when volunteer has symptoms, get infected by COVID, or accident*
- ☐ *Provide referral for health services in case the symptoms arise or infected by COVID*
- ☐ *Provide insurance for accident and death (national insurance plan)*



## *Ensuring Volunteer Safety for the COVID Operation (2)*

### *Disinfection Activity:*

- ☐ *Volunteer should be in healthy condition, no health concerns*
- ☐ *Medical check before disinfection activity*
- ☐ *Clear job distribution in one team: sprayer, logistician, health personnel*
- ☐ *Wear standard PPE*
- ☐ *Procedures on how to do the safe and proper disinfection*
- ☐ *Clean and decontaminate the PPE*
- ☐ *Do personal hygiene after disinfection activity*
- ☐ *Medical check after disinfection activity*
- ☐ *Maximum 3x doing disinfection in one day, with 30 minutes spraying time, and 30 minutes interval break between each spraying*
- ☐ *Not touching of food/drink directly during the break*
- ☐ *Maximum spraying 3 days in a week with one day-off interval*
