

Purpose of the Call for Proposals

"This Call for Proposals aims at empowering the RCRC youth of Southeast Asia by providing them with a concrete opportunity to conceptualise and implement projects that will benefit vulnerable communities in their countries and / or in the Southeast Asia region."

Responding to the call of RCRC SEA Leaders



- a) Digitalization The use of technology to improve a process, system, workflow, or service (also training) of the National Society/ies, to increase the efficiency and effectiveness of RCRC work.
- **b) Blood donation** To raise awareness, advocate, encourage and support eligible donors to donate blood in their home country.
- c) Health Promotion, including First Aid, COVID19, Mental Health and Psychosocial Support Activities that benefit the physical and mental wellbeing of the RCRC staff, volunteers and/or the vulnerable population.
- **d) Climate Resilience Action** Activities that build the knowledge and capacity of RCRC staff, volunteers and communities and that mobilize positive action to address climate-induced disasters and the climate and environmental crises.
